

Terms & Conditions for participation



Background

Colour Your Hair for Mental Health is an initiative of the Neuroscience Research Australia Foundation (A.B.N. 57008429961) (**NeuRA Foundation**), a registered charity. The initiative aims to raise funds and to increase awareness and reduce the stigma surrounding mental illness in our community.

Individuals, organisations, schools and workplaces are encouraged to register and fundraise to support this initiative. Funds raised will help support NeuRA's valuable research into improving the lives of those living with mental illness.

To make sure your participation is as smooth as possible you must comply with these terms and conditions (**T&Cs**).

1. Fundraising

1.1. (**registration**) You can sign up with the NeuRA Foundation by:

- (a) (**phone**) calling us on 1300 888 019, or
- (b) (**email**) emailing colouryourhair@neura.edu.au; or
- (c) (**website**) registering at www.colouryourhair.com.au

Once you have registered, you will receive a 'welcome email' from the NeuRA Foundation confirming your participation.

1.2. (**Hosting Events**) If you, your workplace, school or organisation intends to host a fundraising event (e.g. hosting a BBQ, morning tea or trivia night) in which you will receive cash donations from participants or attendees, please let us know. The NeuRA Foundation will provide you with an 'Authorisation to Fundraise' letter. This letter is required by law. It confirms your fundraising event is registered to participate in the Colour Your Hair for Mental Health initiative.

1.3. (**Fundraising Guidelines apply**) These T&Cs should be read with the NeuRA Foundation's complete fundraising guidelines which can be found [here](#).

1.4. (**participation**) All participation is voluntary. Participants can stop fundraising and participating in the initiative at any time.

1.5. (**under 18**) Participants who are under 18 years of age must have permission from a parent or caregiver before participating. The NeuRA Foundation may require evidence to support this (e.g. a signed consent form).

- 1.6. **(Ensuring everyone participating complies with these T&Cs)** You may be fundraising as an individual or an organisation (e.g. a school or corporate entity) or other (e.g. group of friends). All participants must be aware of and agree to these T&Cs and the NeuRA Foundation's fundraising guidelines. By participating in the Colour Your Hair for Mental Health initiative, you are required to comply with these T&Cs and the NeuRA Foundation's fundraising guidelines.

2. Your responsibilities

- 2.1. **(general responsibilities)** You are responsible for ensuring:
- (a) all fundraising is managed in an appropriate and responsible way
 - (b) the safety of all fundraising, including appropriate public liability insurance and first aid services as needed
 - (c) your participation and/or fundraising event complies with all applicable policies and procedures relevant to any site where participation or a fundraising event takes place (e.g. policies of a school and/or workplace, health and safety policies). You must also ensure that all relevant permissions / consents are obtained.
- 2.2. **(laws)** All fundraising activities must comply with applicable laws. You are also responsible for ensuring you organise any permits, licenses, insurance or authorities for the fundraising activities.
- 2.3. **(raffle and competition guidelines)** If your participation involves a raffle or competition, you must follow the guidelines specified by the relevant state government regulations.
- 2.4. **(door knocking)** Rules may apply to doorknocking the general public. Special permits may be required otherwise the practice may be unlawful.
- 2.5. **(legal matters)** You are responsible for ensuring that all donations raised are properly passed on to the NeuRA Foundation.

3. Colouring your hair

- 3.1. **(follow applicable instructions)** If you are colouring your own or someone else's hair as part of your participation, please read and follow all instructions on the packaging. Ensure participants conduct any recommended skin testing, have appropriate ventilation, eye protection, scalp care, clothing protection or other recommended safety steps and precautions before colouring hair.
- 3.2. **(use non- permanent colouring)** Participants may wish to consider the use of non-permanent products, which wash out easily.
- 3.3. **(safety)** If you are colouring someone else's hair, you should wear disposable gloves. You should also ensure you cover the eyes of participants when spraying their hair (e.g. by using a piece of plastic or cardboard).
- 3.4. **(offensive material)** You should ensure no offensive colouring, negative expressions or symbols are used when colouring participants' hair. We are not responsible for such acts.

4. Donations

- 4.1. (**donations**) Donations are non-refundable and non-transferable. The proceeds must be remitted to NeuRA Foundation within 30 days of your participation.
- 4.2. (**tax deduction**) Donations over \$2 are tax-deductable. Receipt books can be obtained from the NeuRA Foundation. To be tax-deductable, a donor cannot receive anything in return for their donation (e.g. raffle ticket).
- 4.3. (**cost and expenses**) We are not responsible for any costs or expenses incurred in conducting or promoting your participation.

5. Use of Logos

- 5.1. If you wish to use the NeuRA Foundation's registered logo's to support your participation and fundraising, you can download logos and other resources from www.colouryourhair.com.au. These are provided solely for this purpose.

6. Privacy
